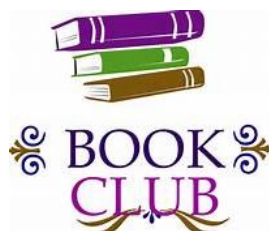
Literary Terms

Personification– a kind of metaphor that gives non-living objects or ideas human characteristics

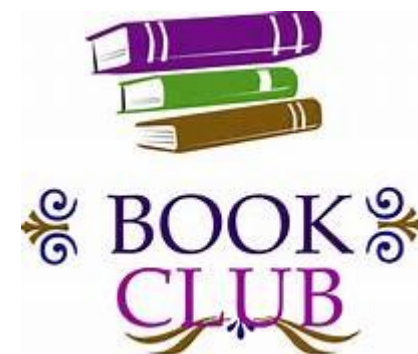
Protagonist– the central character of a piece of writing.
