HBC MAKES EDUCATION AFFORDABLE

Student Payment Plans for Non-Financial Aid Students

HBC 50/50 Plan- Undergraduate Students

Undergraduate first time students not receiving financial aid may receive for the first year only a 50 percent discount when taking two or more classes.

Under the 50/50 Plan, a student taking two classes will pay \$130 per month for five months (includes books and fees). The first payment must be received before registration can be completed. Monthly payments for students taking more than two classes will have to be computed using 50 percent of the costs divided by 5. Students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher may request an additional year.

HBC 25/75 Plan-Master of Ministry Students

Students enrolled in the Master of Ministry program taking 9 hours or more are eligible for 25% off of tuition.

Under the 25/75 Plan, graduate students in the Master of Ministry program taking 9 hours will pay \$300 per month for five months (includes fees). The first payment must be received before registration can be completed.

HBC Cohort Plan- Doctor of Ministry Students

Students in the Doctor of Ministry Cohort taking 6 credit hours are eligible for this payment plan.

Under the Cohort Plan, a student taking 6 hours will pay \$375 per month for five months (includes all fees). The first payment must be received before registration can be completed.

HBC Scholarship Plan-This plan provides scholarships for qualifying students to help defray tuition costs.


