

CERTIFICATE IN CHURCH MINISTRY

Overview

This certificate program teaches the foundation of the Bible and the fundamentals of church ministry.

The goal is to prepare both clergy and laity for ministry in the church in a practical way.

The program requires 30 semester credit hours for a student who may or may not wish to pursue a college degree, however most of the course work will transfer to an Associate or Bachelor Degree program.

The instruction is designed for shorter periods of time. The courses will be 8 weeks in length.

Program Objectives

Upon completion of this certificate, the student will be able to:

- Demonstrate basic knowledge of the Bible
- Exhibit a fundamental understanding of Christian doctrine
- Demonstrate knowledge of church ministry and current administrative principles and practices in the Black prospective
- Exhibit proper use of the Bible in relation to real world issues such as finances, family life, and grief
- Demonstrate a clearer understanding of the Bible as it is re-read within a cultural context

Cost and Commitment

The student who signs up for this program is asked to take at least one or more classes for each session.

Fall

(Session 1: August 15 through October 15)

(Session 2: October 21 through December 13)

Spring

(Session 1: January 6 through February 29)

(Session 2: March 9 through May 1)

The cost per class is \$150 per 2 credit hours for students paying out of pocket. This reduced cost is offset by a scholarship. Students seeking financial aid (pell, loan or VA) will pay the regular price.

A total of 30 semester hours may be transferred to an Associate or Bachelor Degree program.

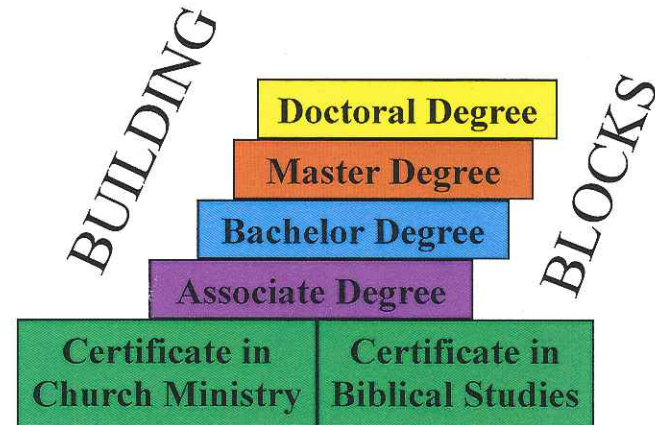
