HBC Receives Supplemental Award to the CARES Act Grant

Huntsville Bible College received a supplemental award to the CARES Act Grant issued by the Department of Education February 22, 2021. This increased funds to the previous CARES Act Grant that was received April 18, 2020 for colleges and universities to assist students impacted by the Coronavirus outbreak.

This referred only to students who were Pell-eligible and taking on campus classes (face-to-face) but had to transition to online and or zoom classes. Funding is provided through the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) and authorized by the Coronavirus Aid Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

The entire student body of Huntsville Bible College was notified by email and letters February 25, 2021. Funds were equally distributed to the Pell eligible, on campus students during the spring 2020-2021 semester.
