If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Office of Student Financial Services. The office may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact the Office of Student Financial Aid as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
